ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued for the continuance of the Scheme of "Soil Testing Laboratories, Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories and Central Control Laboratory, Kudumianmalai" from 01.04.2014 to 31.03.2015.

- 2. In his letter second read above, the Director of Agriculture has sent proposals for the continuance of the scheme of Soil Testing Laboratories (30), Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories (16) and Central Control Laboratory, Kudumianmalai for the period from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016 and requested the Government to issue orders for the continuance of the scheme. He has further requested to provide an amount of Rs.316.306 lakh additionally over and above the budget provision for implementation of the "Mission Soil Health Card" scheme of Government of India. He has also informed that the above amount will be reimbursed as and when the funds are received from Government of India.
- 3. The Government after careful examination, accord sanction for further continuance of the scheme of Soil Testing Laboratories, Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories and Central Control Laboratory, Kudumianmalai for the period from 01.04.2015 to 31.03.2016, subject to meeting the expenditure within the Budget Provision. Orders regarding the continuance of the temporary staff for Soil Testing Laboratories, Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories and Central Control Laboratory, Kudumianmalai will be issued separately.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned at para 3 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-
