ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, a sum of Rs.2500.00 lakh [Rs.1250.00 lakh GOI Share: Rs.1250.00 lakh State Share] was sanctioned as first instalment towards the implementation of the Rainfed Area Development Component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture during 2015-16.

- 2. In the letters third read above, Government of India have released an amount of Rs.1933.00 lakh [Rs.1525.14 lakh + Rs.386.60 lakh + Rs.21.26 lakh under General, SCSP and TSP Categories respectively] as second installment under Rainfed Area Development for the year 2015-16.
- 3. In this regard, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has sent the proposals given by the implementing Departments viz., Agriculture, Horticulture, Agricultural Engineering, Agricultural Marketing &

Agri Business and Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency based on the 2nd installment released by the Government of India.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2805.00 lakh (Rupees twenty eight crore and five lakh only) as second instalment towards implementation of the Rainfed Area Development Component under National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture during 2015-16 as detailed below:-

- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the Head of account and component wise details of the projects as mentioned in the annexure to this order.
- 6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.2805.00 are included in Final Modified Appropriation / Final Supplementary Estimate 2015-16 under the relevant head of accounts.
- 7. The Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the Head of the Departments concerned through Electronic clearing system (ECS).

- 8. The concerned Assistant Directors of Agriculture are permitted to draw an advance amount of Rs.55.70 lakh for conducting training programme at Rs.10,000/-per training.
- 9. The Chief Engineer (Agricultural Engineering) is permitted to interchange the physical numbers of 68 within 5 districts based on the feasibility in each of the selected clusters without altering the total financial outlay.
- 10. The implementing Departments should scrupulously follow the National Mission for Sustainable Agriculture Guidelines given by the Government of India and follow the cost norms and pattern of assistance while implementing the projects.
- 11. The implementing Departments should ensure proper implementation of the projects and complete them on time. The respective Head of the Departments should personally oversee and ensure the technical, quality control and reasonableness of rates and estimates of the implementation of the project.
- 12. The implementing Departments should monitor the implementation process and progress at the State & District levels effectively and to furnish the monthly progress reports to the Nodal Agency and to the Government.
- 13. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency is requested to send the monthly progress report to the Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10th of the subsequent month under intimation to the Government without fail.
- 14. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.14208/Agri/2016, Dated 25.02.2016.
