

Agriculture – Sanctioning of additional funds under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana – 2018-19, to the tune of Rs.2400.00 lakh as third instalment during 2019-20 to the Department of Agriculture – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.14189.20 lakh, for implementation of 8 projects of Department of Agriculture and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.42.757 Crore, as 1st instalment release of funds, was accorded, (after deducting an amount of Rs.2886.00 lakh, diverted for Kuruvai Package 2018), under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) for 2018-19.

- 2. In the Government order 2nd read above, financial sanction for a sum of Rs.7027.50 lakh, for implementation of 7 projects of Department of Agriculture, as second instalment release of funds, was accorded under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) / Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) for 2018-19.
- 3. In the letters third read above, the Government of India, have released additional funds to the tune of Rs.46.13 Crore, as Central Share, under RKVY during 2018-19 in the funding pattern of 60:40 between Central and the State Government. By adding the corresponding 40% State share of Rs.30.75 Crore, the total allocation works out to Rs. 76.88 Crore.

- 4. The Director of Agriculture in the letter 4th read above has stated that the construction of Integrated Agricultural Extension Centres (IAEC) in Tamil Nadu (Project No. 16.10) is one among the 8 projects to the tune of Rs.5000.000 lakh approved by 16th SLSC. Out of which, a sum of Rs.1800.000 lakh was accorded to construct 9 number of Integrated Agricultural Extension Centres (at Rs.200.000 lakh per unit) vide Government order 1st and 2nd read above.
- 5. The Director of Agriculture has now requested to sanction a sum of Rs.2400.00 lakh (Government of India share- Rs.1440.00 lakh, State share Rs.960.00 lakh) as third instalment to take up the project, "construction of 12 Integrated Agricultural Extension Centres (IAEC)". The Director of Agriculture has also requested to implement the scheme, at the rate of Rs.200.000 lakh per unit in 11000 sq ft. for establishment of 12 numbers of Integrated Agricultural Extension Centres with godown facilities. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has recommended the above proposal.
- 6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Director of Agriculture at para.5 above and sanction a sum of Rs.2400.00 lakh (Rupees Twenty Four Crore Only) for establishment of 12 numbers of Integrated Agricultural Extension Centres with godown facilities under National Agriculture Development Programme/Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana during 2019-20.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para.6 above shall be debited to the Head of Account mentioned in the annexure to this order.
- 8. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2019-20 by reappropriation as detailed below:-

- 9. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Agriculture is authorized to draw and disburse a sum of Rs.2400.00 lakh sanctioned in para.6 above to the concerned for implementing the projects. However, the expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2018-19. The Director of Agriculture is directed to include this expenditure while sending the Budget proposal for RE/FMA 2019-20 and also to send necessary draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2019-20 to the Government in Finance (BG-I/Agri) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
- 10. The Director of Agriculture should take due care to ensure that there is no duplication of subsidy.
- 11. The Chief Engineer (AED) is permitted and authorized to operate the Capital outlay Heads of Account (viz., 4401-00-103-UA, 4401-00-793-UA & 4401-00-794-UA) under National Agriculture Development Programme through Treasury Heads of Account.

- 12. The Director of Agriculture and the Chief Engineer (AED) are directed to strictly adhere to the other instructions issued in Government Order 1st read above.
- 13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.19565/Agri/2019, dated: 24.05.2019 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.318 (Three hundred and eighteen)
