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ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have conveyed approval of Annual Action Plan for an total outlay of Rs.5844.80 lakh (GOI share Rs.3506.880 lakh + State Share Rs. 2337.920 lakh) comprising NFSM – Rice, at Rs.1071.000 lakh, NFSM – Pulses, at Rs.3384.300 lakh, NFSM - Coarse Cereals, at Rs. 272.900 lakh, NFSM – Nutri cereals at Rs. 1116.600 lakh for implementation of “National Food Security Mission (National Food Security Mission).

2. In the Government Order 2nd read above, orders were issued according administrative approval for Rs.6042.950 lakh and financial sanction for Rs.2922.400 lakh, as First instalment, for implementation of “National Food Security Mission (National Food Security Mission) for the year 2020-2021.

*Unspent balance of Rs.1.09 lakh of NFSM - Intercropping of Pulses with Sugarcane, Rs.10.05 lakh of Special plan for increasing Pulses productivity and Rs.8.46 lakh of Targeting Rice fallow areas are adjusted /revalidated under NFSM-Pulses.

**Excess Unspent balance of Rs.0.67 lakh, over and above the allocation of NFSM-Rice, is adjusted and revalidated under NFSM-Coarse cereals.

6. In the letter 5th read above, the DOA has stated that as per Audited Utilisation Certificate furnished to the Government of India for the year 2019-20, the unspent balance amount of Rs.347.047 lakh as GOI share is only available in the NFSM bank accounts maintained at districts and the Nodal Agency, Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency under National Food Security Mission all crop schemes. But, as per the Government of India sanction letter, the unspent amount is mentioned as Rs.399.620 lakh. Hence the total amount of Rs.249.840 lakh as GOI share, under all the NFSM components, is only to be revalidated and the remaining amount of Rs.97.207 lakh (Rs.347.047 lakh - Rs.249.840 lakh) as Government of India share, is kept unutilized in the NFSM bank account maintained at the State and the District level and it will be utilized in the next financial year (2021-22). In the letter 5th read above, the Director of Agriculture, has sent the detailed proposal, for release of 2nd instalment fund, under National Food Security Mission and for revalidation of unspent amount. He has requested to accord financial sanction for Rs.2216.633 lakh (Rs. 1353.820 lakh Central share and State share Rs. 862.813 lakh) as the second instalment release of funds, under NFSM, for the year 2020 – 2021 and to revalidate the unspent balance of 2019-20, for a sum of Rs.416.399 lakh (Rs.249.840 lakh as Central share and State share Rs.166.559 lakh) and also sought permission to utilize the amount available in NFSM bank accounts maintained at the District level and the State Nodal Agency, Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency, for implementation of NFSM along with the second installment fund release, during the year 2020-21. He has also requested to provide authorization to permit and utilize the unspent amount, totalling to a sum of

Rs. 416.399 lakh, under approved components of National Food Security Mission for the year 2020 – 21.

8. The Government after careful examination, of the proposal of the Director of Agriculture, hereby accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs. 2216.633 lakh (Rupees twenty two crore sixteen lakh sixty three thousand and three hundred only) (Central share - Rs.1353.820 lakh and State share - Rs.862.813 lakh) as the second instalment release of funds under NFSM for the year 2020 – 2021 and permit the Director of Agriculture, to utilize the unspent balance of 2019-20 for a sum of Rs.416.399 lakh (Rs.249.840 lakh as Central share and State share Rs.166.559 lakh) available with him. The details are furnished in Annexure I to V.


