## ABSTRACT

### ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for continuing the Crop Yield Competitions at State and District Level during 2016-2017 and sanctioned a sum of Rs.20.85 lakh for conducting the competitions.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Agriculture has sent proposal for continuing these Crop Yield Competitions at State and District Level during 2017-2018 and requested to sanction a sum of Rs.17.90 lakh for conducting 88 Nos. of District Level Competitions and Rs.2.70 lakh for conducting 9 Nos. of State Level Competitions and Rs.25,000/- for tour travel allowance, totaling Rs.20.85 lakh for both District and State Level Competitions so as to achieve the object of Crop Yield Competition.

3. The Director of Agriculture has further stated that the prize money for the Crop Yield Competitions for the year 2017-18 are as detailed below:-
